








Do you tow vehicles that have not been moved?




Do you ticket, instead of towing, vehicles that have not been moved?






Is there an appeal procedure for appealing disputed tows or tickets?








Is the operation of your program written into City Code or only an Administrative Procedure?








How many times per year do you sweep your downtown business district?


